1 ON 1 MEETINGS WITH TEACHERS

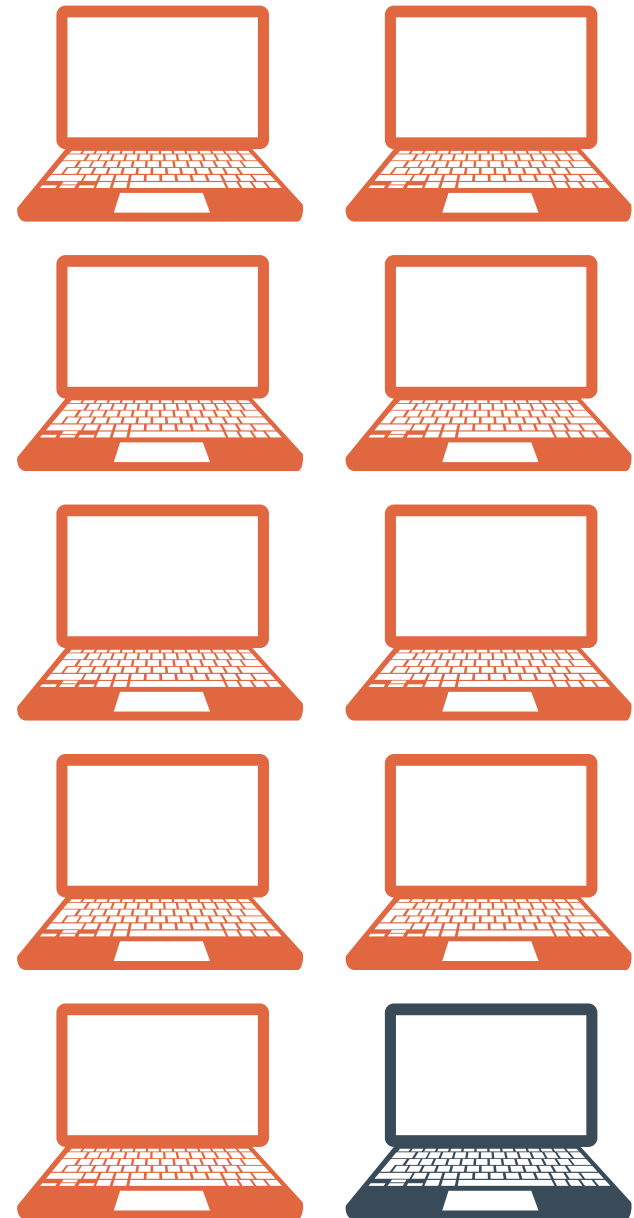
nearly 1 In 3 parents say they have not had a one on one meeting with their child's teacher or school since the beginning of the school year.

ACCESS TO LEARNING DEVICES

nearly 9 in 10 parents report they have access to a learning device for each child in their home.

94% of parents report that their child's school offered them a learning device.

ACCESS TO THE INTERNET

nearly 9 in 10 parents report they have adequate internet in their home to support online learning.

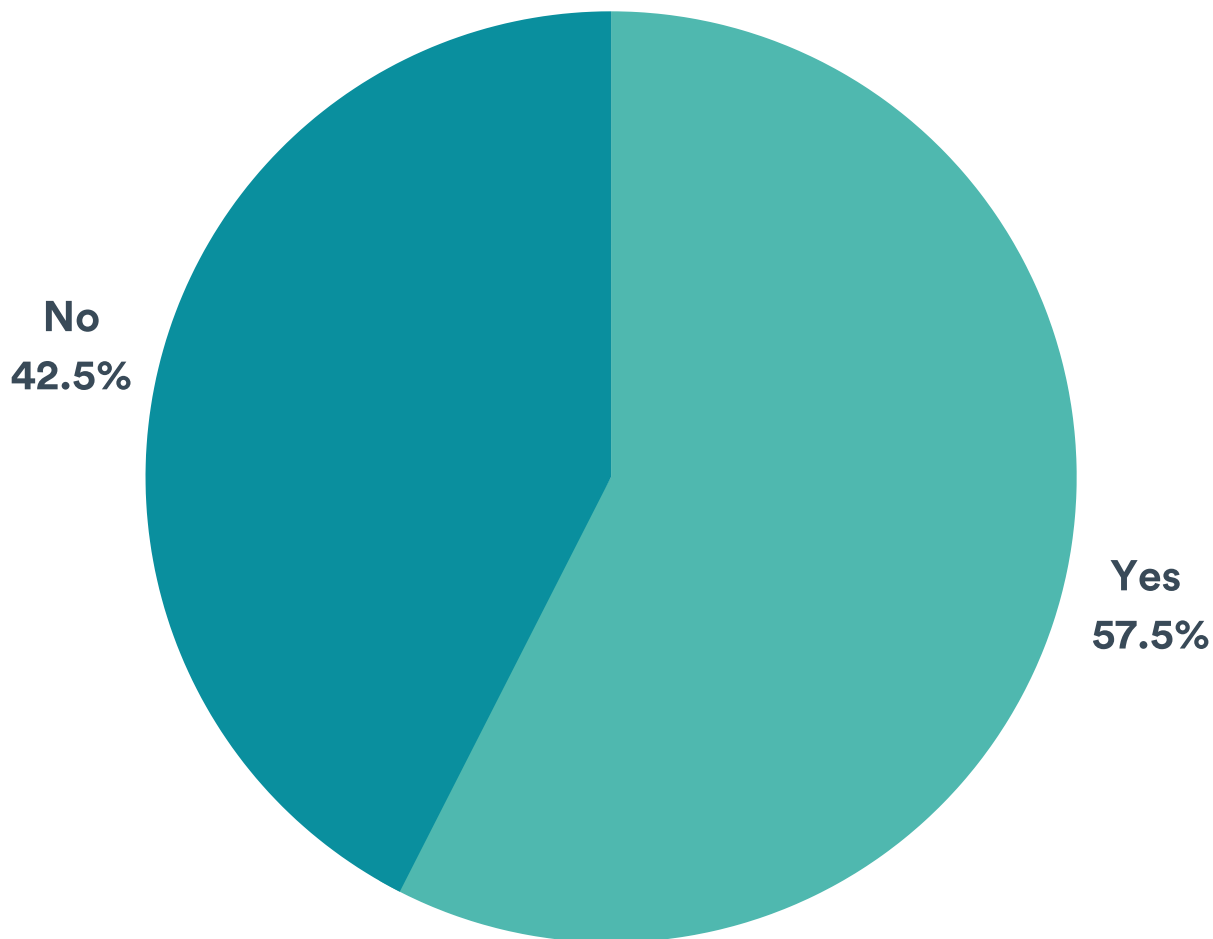
only 61% of parents report they were offered internet service or a hot spot from their school or district.

ACCESS TO PRINTERS

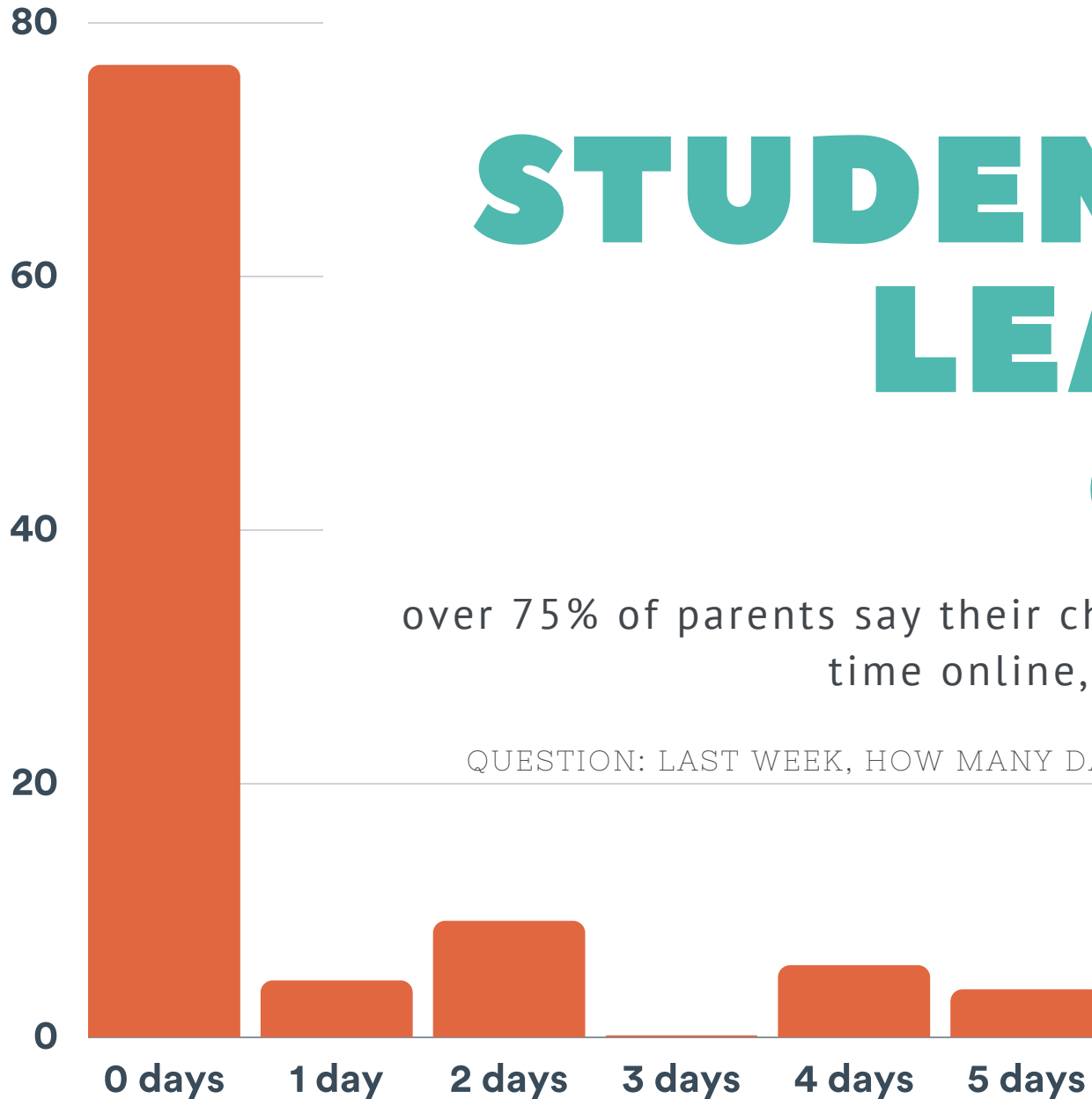
over 40% of parents say their child does NOT have access to a printer at home

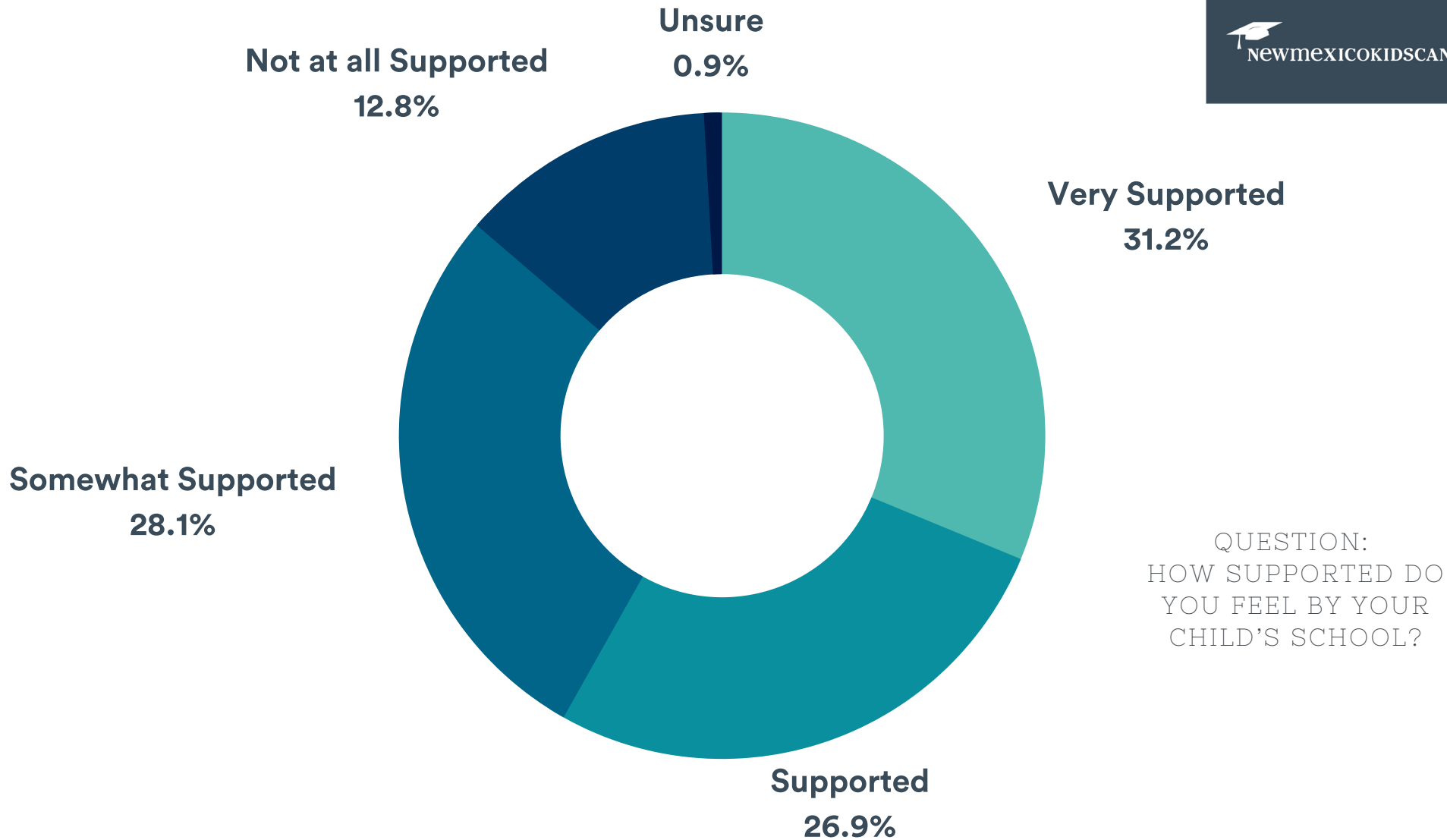


MOST STUDENTS ARE LEARNING ONLINE

QUESTION: LAST WEEK, HOW MANY DAYS DID YOUR CHILD GO TO SCHOOL IN PERSON?



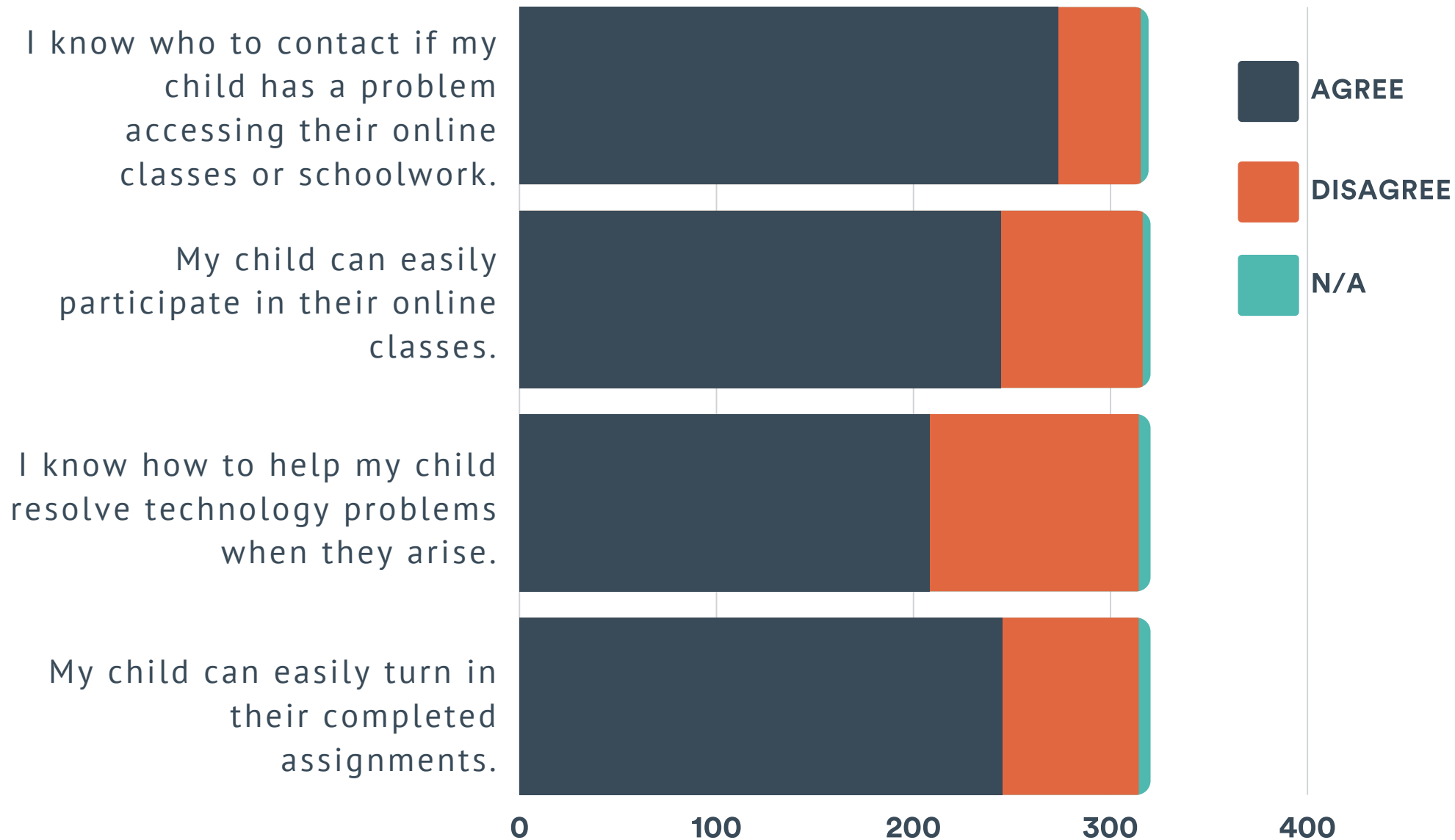

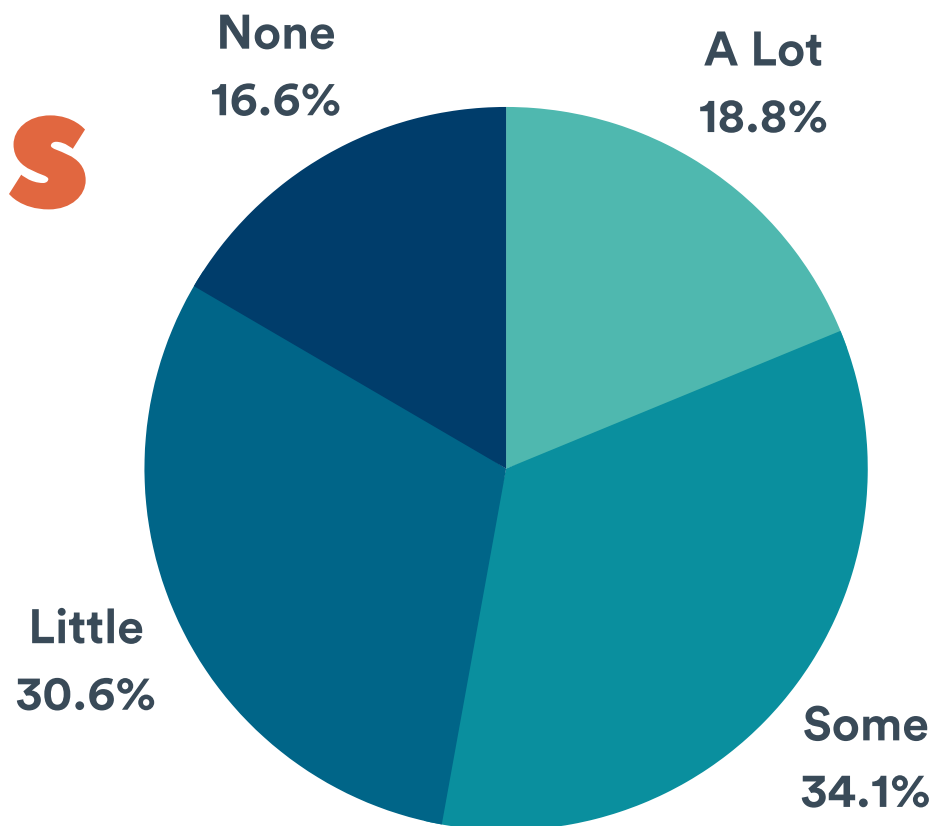

PARENTS SAY THEIR CHILD LEARNS BETTER AT SCHOOL

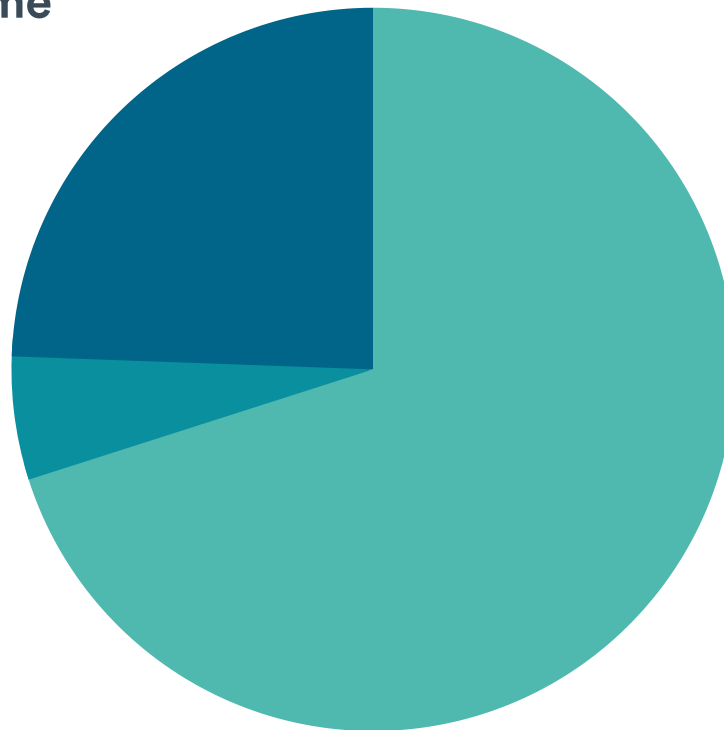
an overwhelming 70% of parents say their child learns better at school than at home

IN PERSON INSTRUCTION NEEDED

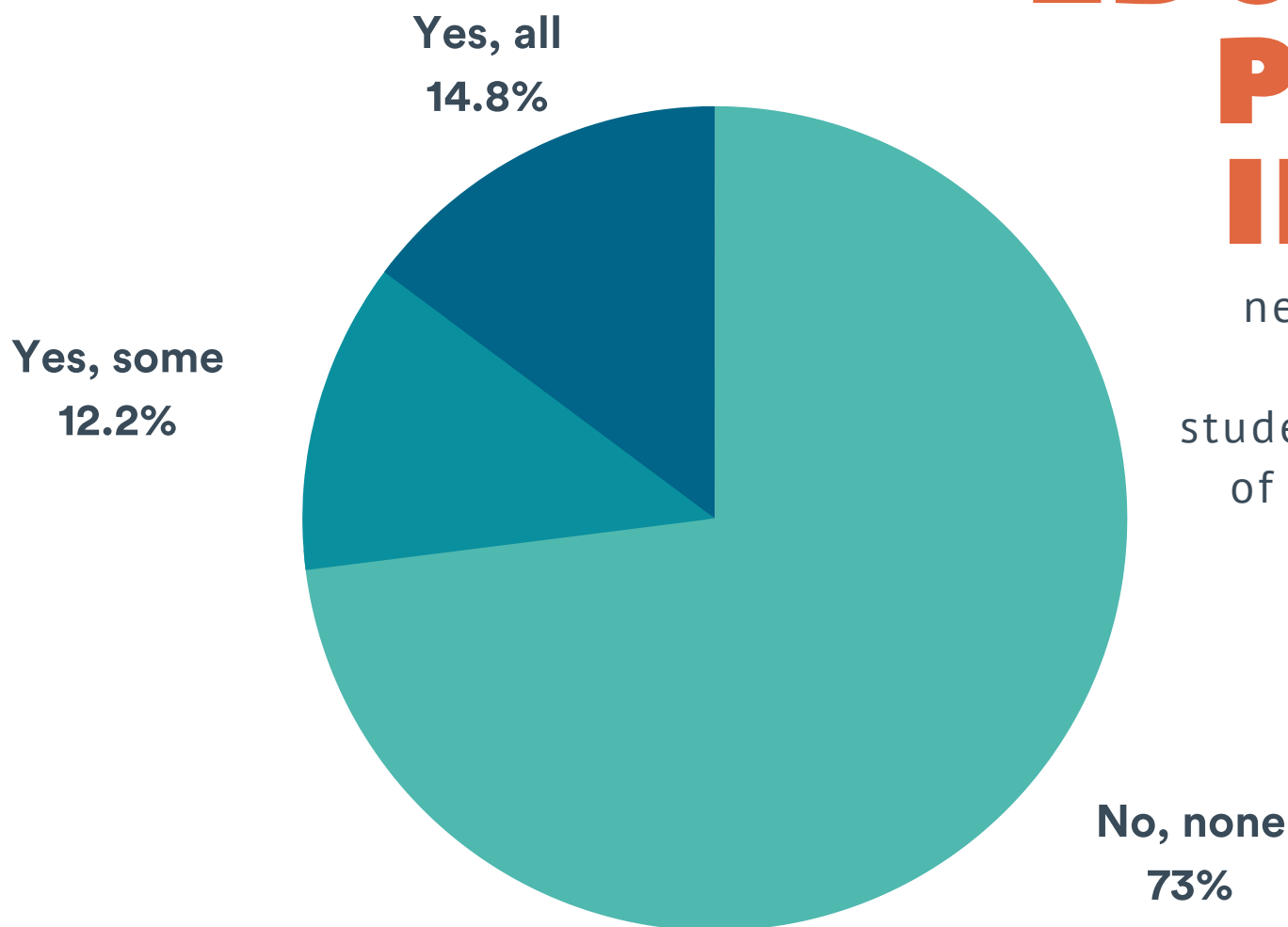
the majority of parents say access to in person, small group instruction would be the most helpful resource
